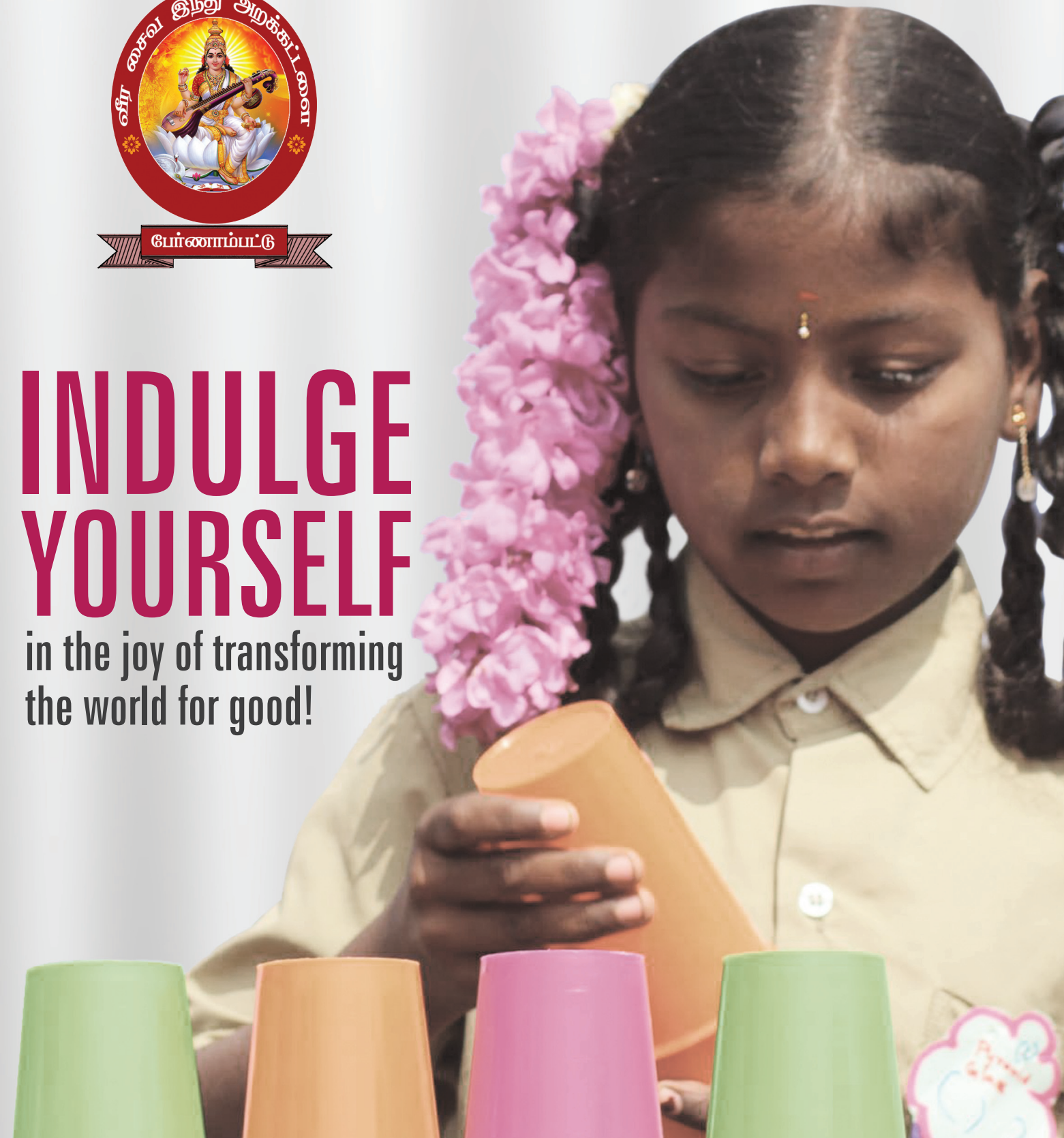

Pernambut, a small town in Vellore district predominantly accommodates backward, economically weaker and underprivileged society of people working for daily wages in tanneries, farms and tobacco factories. To eradicate illiteracy there, the primary way would be setting up a free centre for quality education.

Under the able guidance of B.A. Balasubramaniam and family, the school currently operates with nearly 1000 students and offers education up to 8th Standard along with extra-curricular activities like Karate, Cricket, Yoga, etc.

What started as a small hub for education with just 10 students, now serves as an educational landmark in the neighborhood of Pernambut!

The Initiative

BAB Leather Groups, a premium Leather manufacturing and exporting company formed and registered VEERA SAIVA HINDU CHARITABLE TRUST to establish Kalaimagal Middle School in the year 1983.

As a part of BAB's Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), four acres of land was gifted for the construction of the school. Around twelve class rooms with all the basic amenities including a compound wall were built for the students. There are also plans to expand it as a high school and continue the legacy with a Polytechnic College and a Health Care Centre.
